## Our LMS—Learning Management System

The Ministry of Justice with the support of the European Union developed a Learning Management Platform, called **HERMES**, which will be part of the e-Justice Portal.

Our aim is to deliver **50 basic and advanced courses** for prison staff and CVE practitioners in **27 EU countries**.



The platform  deploys **innovative technologies** and concepts to deliver complex juridical and technical knowledge through **virtual environments** composed of videos and exercises based upon **real cases**.

This methodology helps to contextualize and understand complex phenomena of radicalization within prisons as part of daily duties and activities of the prison staff, with a **very practical approach** which combines EU regulations, practices and policies with the national strategies.

HERMES is a real innovative tool, which offers the opportunity to work together with a European view
