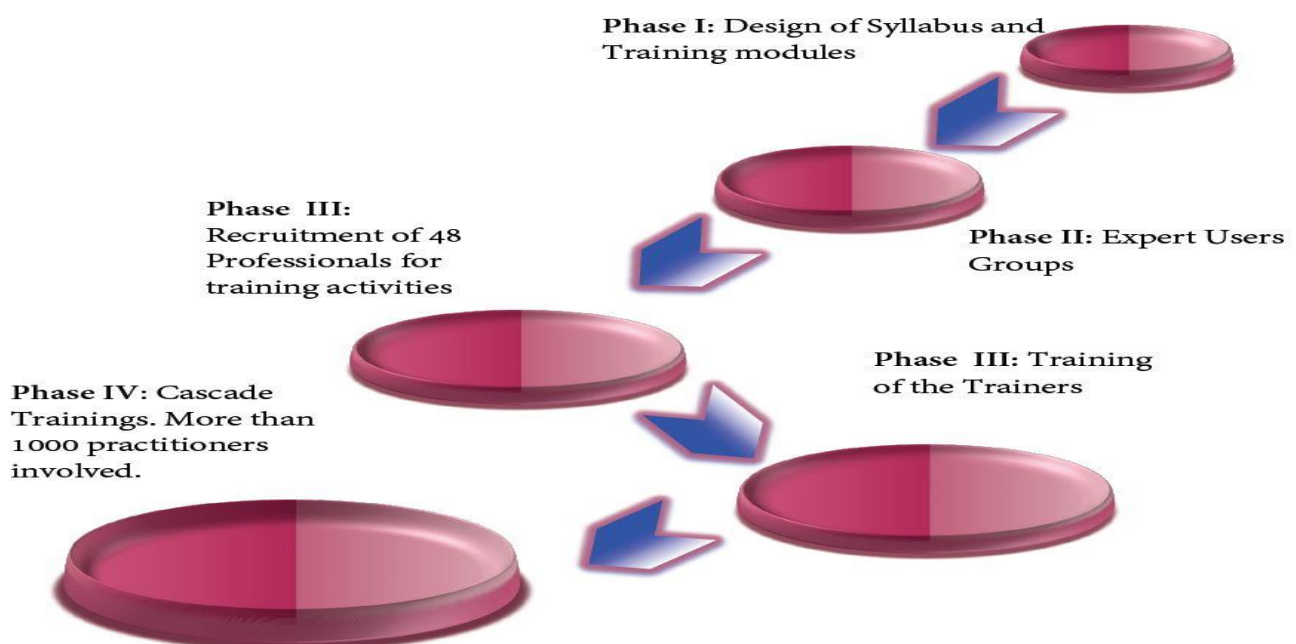

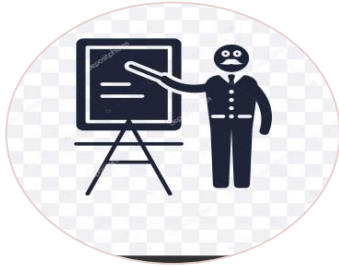
COUNTER RADICALISATION THROUGH THE RULE OF LAW

[DERAD](#) is an European Project that aims to prevent the escalation of radicalization in the prison environment and help prisoners and probationers, who are often exposed to Jihadist recruitment or self-radicalization, to overcome the different problems and push factors usually exploited by recruiters, aspects that DERAD project aims to approach.

Another important objective of the project was the formalization of an inter-agency group, for cross-sectors specialized in dealing with radicalized detainees. The specific project actions were directed to create original contents for the training of 55 European trainers with e-learning modalities on the phenomenon of radicalization and to organize cascade training activities in 26 countries. These are, in details, the phases of the project:
