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1 Introduction

ISDEP (Improving Security By Democratic Participation) is based on the EU Commission's Counter Terrorism strategy. It aims to prevent people turning to terrorism by tackling the factors or root causes which can lead to radicalisation and recruitment, in Europe and internationally.

The project partner member states working in ISDEP demonstrate an excellent geographical spread, involving members from northern, southern and Eastern Europe.


ISDEP will work with you as front line sector staff through the development of a number of resources for training to raise awareness around the processes that lead to radicalisation. This will allow you to recognise, respond and challenge the ideology and narratives associated with any form of terrorism, ultimately creating a safeguarding mechanism for vulnerable individuals.





Before you can enter the platform you have to create an account. Please click "Create new account".




Please fill in the required data. Please note: For technical reasons the work sector choice will always appear in English.



Click "Create my new account".


After this you will receive an automatically generated confirmation mail from **moodleadmin@oncampus.de**. Please check your e-mail folder and your spam folder, too.



Please click on the link in this mail to confirm your new account. Now you can log in at the ISDEP e-learning platform.






