In Palermo, the TRUST technical table composed of representatives from law enforcement, the Muslim community and civil society works collectively to address the challenges that unite us:

- Create more meeting spaces where Muslim women and women from all communities can discuss common problems, such as gender-based violence.
- Do not stereotype Muslim women, regardless of their country of origin. Every story is unique, and all stories deserve respect and to be represented and told.
- Through participatory dialogue, the underlying prejudices and stereotypes towards a united, aware and informed community are broken.

...safe spaces for every woman

The sense of community among Muslim women, whatever their country of origin, is lacking. We need to build strong bonds between the different communities, promoting dialogue and mutual understanding.

In Palermo, we are working to create more public meeting spaces for Muslim women and others. Places where they can share experiences, traditions and develop new friendships.

...educating for a better future

Common ground for cultural and interreligious interaction is essential in Italian schools, high schools, universities and all public service spaces. Educating for differences is the key to a more inclusive and conscious future.

In Palermo, we are working through specific trainings to professionals and in schools for a future in which Muslim women and all women feel an integral and representative part of the community.
